**DONRELL GATES et al. v. JONATHAN GLASS et al.**

Court of Appeals Case No. A11A1169

The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Thompson, Hines and Nahmias, JJ., who dissent.

This case will be assigned to the April 2012 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals err in holding that the definition of “any motor vehicle” in OCGA ss 33-24-51(a) continues to be the broader definition of the term provided for in prior case law, notwithstanding the 2002 passage of House Bill 1128?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
