This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals err in holding that a contract between a school district and a private company for services regarding the renovation and repair of school facilities qualifies as a contract covering a proprietary function within the meaning of OCGA § 20-2-506 (h) so as to eliminate the need for the contract to comply with the provisions of OCGA § 20-2-506 (b)?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
