The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Hines, J., not participating.

This case will be assigned to the February 2012 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Whether the Court of Appeals erred in reversing the trial court's grant of partial summary judgment by holding that BB&T failed to satisfy the Statute of Frauds so that no valid foreclosure sale occurred and the confirmation process under OCGA § 44-14-161 did not apply.

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
