TROY DAVIS SEEKS STAY OF EXECUTION

Atlanta, September 16, 2008 – Attorneys for Troy Anthony Davis have asked the Supreme Court of Georgia to stay his sentence of death by lethal injection while they seek to appeal his case to the U.S. Supreme Court. Davis is scheduled to be executed a week from today – Tuesday, Sept. 23 – at 7:00 P.M. at the Georgia Diagnostic and Classification Prison in Jackson, GA. He was convicted of the 1989 murder of Savannah Police Officer Mark Allen MacPhail.
