The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

The Court having considered the motion to amend the Rules and Regulations of the State Bar of Georgia, it is ordered that the State Bar's motion to amend Rule 1-502 of Chapter 5 of Part I of the Rules of the State Bar of Georgia regarding amount of license fees, by raising the cap on the annual license fee paid by attorneys from \$250.00 to \$350.00, is hereby approved. It is hereby ordered that the Rules and Regulations of the Organization and Government of the State Bar of Georgia be amended to read as follows:

Rule 1-502. Amount of License Fees

The amount of such license fees for active members shall not exceed \$350.00, and shall annually be fixed by the Board of Governors for the ensuing year; provided, however, that except in the case of an emergency, such annual dues shall not be increased in any one year by more than \$25.00 over those set for the next preceding year. The annual license fee for inactive members shall be in an amount not to exceed one-half (1/2) of those set for active members. Subject to the above limitations, license fees may be fixed in differing amounts for different classifications of active and inactive membership, as may be established in the bylaws.
