**SUN STATES INSURANCE GROUP, INC. v. STATE OF GEORGIA, EX REL RALPH
T. HUDGENS, COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE et al.**

Court of Appeals Case No. A14A2120

The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur.

This case will be assigned to the January 2016 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

- (1) Whether the Court of Appeals correctly determined that the State had not waived sovereign immunity with respect to Sun States Insurance Group, Inc.'s claim for a surcharge.
- (2) If the Court of Appeals correctly determined that the State had not waived sovereign immunity, did it err in holding that OCGA 33-37-8.1 (b) may provide an exception to sovereign immunity.

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
