This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

In a case not involving conspiracy charges, does a defendant by pleading not guilty make intent a material issue for the purposes of OCGA § 24-4-404 (b). See e.g. *United States v. Edouard*, 485 F3d 1324 (11th Cir. 2007); *Bradshaw v. State*, 296 Ga. 650 (769 SE2d 892) (2015).

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
