The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Benham, Hunstein, and Melton, JJ., who dissent

This case will be assigned to the February 2016 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals err in holding that a campus policeman of the University System of Georgia has jurisdiction to make arrests for a traffic violation committed in his presence, but more than 500 yards off campus? See OCGA Sections 20-3-72, 40-13-30, and 17-4-23.

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
