The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur.

This case will be assigned to the July 2016 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

- (1) Did the Court of Appeals err in concluding that text messages sent to the cell phone found in petitioner's possession were admissible as party admissions?
- (2) Did the Court of Appeals err in concluding that the trial court did not err in denying petitioner's motion in limine to exclude the text messages?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
