Did the Court of Appeals err in holding that deposition testimony of an organizational representative taken under OCGA § 9-11-30 (b) (6) may be admitted into evidence at trial under OCGA § 9-11-32 (a) (2) without regard to the rules of evidence governing admissibility of expert testimony, see OCGA § 24-7-702?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
