The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Benham, J., who dissents.

This case will be assigned to the January 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals err in its determination that a redeeming creditor after a tax sale does not have a first priority claim on excess tax funds? See *Wester v. United Capital Financial of Atlanta, LLC*, 282 Ga. App. 392 (638 SE2d 779) (2006) and *United Capital Financial of Atlanta v. American Investment Assoc.*, 302 Ga. App. 400 (691 SE2d 272) (2010).

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
