The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur.

This case will be assigned to the March 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

- (1) Did the plaintiff substantially comply with OCGA § 36-11-1 by sending ante litem notice to the County Attorney?
- (2) Did the Court of Appeals err in affirming the grant of summary judgment to the County on the issue of whether the time for presenting ante litem notice was tolled by the plaintiff's mental disability?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
