WHO MUST FILE A RULE 3.15 ANNUAL DISCLOSURE REPORT [See Rule 3.15 (A), (C)]

- All judges, whether full-time, part-time, or pro tempore, who served for any portion of the calendar year, must file a Rule 3.15 Annual Disclosure Report, even if the report states that no reportable extra-judicial compensation or gifts or similar benefits were received.

WHO MUST REPORT EXTRA-JUDICIAL COMPENSATION [See Application Section (A)(1), (B)(1), Rule 3.15 (A)(1)]

- Full-time judge

WHO MUST REPORT GIFTS OR SIMILAR BENEFITS [See Rule 3.15 (A)(2)]

- Full-time judges
Part-time judges
Judges pro tempore

WHAT INFORMATION MUST BE REPORTED [See Rule 3.15 (B)]

- The date, source, amount, and nature of the activity for which the judge received any reportable extra-judicial compensation. Income received simply from owning investments does not need to be reported.
The date, source, value and description of any reportable gift or similar benefit accepted.

WHEN TO FILE THE REPORT [See Rule 3.15 (D)]

- The report must be filed between January 1 and April 15 for the previous calendar year.

WHERE TO FILE THE REPORT

- Reports should be filed with the office of the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Georgia using this form.

Rule 3.15 Reports and Procedures for Reporting

(A) Judges shall regularly file reports on the amount or value of:

(1) compensation received for extra-judicial activities involving personal services as permitted by Rules 3.1 (C), 3.2, 3.7, 3.8, 3.11, and 3.14, if the value of such compensation exceeds \$500 in the same calendar year.

Note: Unlike the reporting of gifts or similar benefits, which is triggered by the receipt of more than \$500 in total value from the *same* source in the calendar year, the reporting of extra-judicial compensation involving personal services is triggered by the receipt of more than \$500 in total value from *all* sources in the calendar year.
