The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Peterson, J., disqualified.

This case will be assigned to the June 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Must an employer show the availability of suitable employment to justify suspension of workers' compensation benefits after already establishing that an employee's work-related aggravation to a preexisting condition has ceased to be the cause of the employee's disability?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
