Whether the Court of Appeals erred in determining that bond validation orders conclusively determined, for purposes of OCGA § 48-5-41 (a) (1) (A), that the property at issue is "public property" exempt from ad valorem taxation?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
