



SUPREME COURT OF GEORGIA

Atlanta April 3, 2008

The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.
The following order was passed:

It is ordered that Uniform Superior Court Rules 13.1 (D) (relating to closing argument time limitations) be revised as follows:

Rule 13.1. Time limitations.

Counsel shall be limited in their arguments as follows:

- (A) Felony cases punishable by the death penalty or life in prison 2 hours each side.
- (B) Any other felony case 1 hour each side.
- (C) Misdemeanor case 30 minutes each side.
- (D) Civil cases other than appeals from magistrate courts 2 hours each side.
- (E) Appeals from magistrate courts 30 minutes each side.

It is further ordered that the Uniform Superior Court Rules be hereby amended to add Rule 24.10 (providing a form for parenting plans in permanent custody and custody modification actions) to read as attached; that the Family Violence Protective Orders be revised to read as attached; and that the Child Support Addendum to the Family Violence Protective Order read as attached.
