



## SUPREME COURT OF GEORGIA

Atlanta January 6, 2016

The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

It is ordered that the Rules Governing Admission to the Practice of Law, Part B, Section 1(a) and (c) (Board of Bar Examiners) be revised to amend the last sentence in subsection (a), and to reflect a fee increase to \$7,500 per examination for each member of the Board in subsection (c), such that the amended Rule, effective January 6, 2016, will read as follows:

### **PART B BOARD OF BAR EXAMINERS**

#### **Section 1. Board of Bar Examiners**

(a) The Board of Bar Examiners shall be composed of six members of the State Bar of Georgia who are learned and experienced and of generally recognized ability and integrity appointed by the Court for terms of six years each. Appointments to fill vacancies occurring other than by expiration of a term shall be for the unexpired term. Each member of the Board shall take and subscribe an oath to faithfully, carefully and impartially perform all of the duties imposed upon him or her as a member of the Board of Bar Examiners, which oath shall be entered upon the minutes of the Court. The Court shall designate one of the members of the Board to serve as chair.

(c) Each member of the Board shall receive a fee of \$7,500 per examination. Out of this sum members shall pay their necessary traveling and other expenses incurred in performing the duties of his or her office. Any reasonable and necessary expenses incurred by Examiners or Graders as a result of participating in conferences and grading workshops sponsored by the National Conference of Bar

Examiners and other educational programs shall be reimbursed by the Office of Bar Admissions.
