THOMAS MCCONNELL et al. v. GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

Court of Appeals Case No. A16A0655

The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Peterson and Grant, JJ., disqualified.

This case will be assigned to the June 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

1. Did the Court of Appeals err in not addressing the trial court's holding that McConnell's tort claims were barred by sovereign immunity, which is a jurisdictional issue, before addressing the merits of those claims?
2. If not, did the Court of Appeals err in holding that McConnell's tort claims were properly dismissed on the merits?


Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
