The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Peterson, J., disqualified

This case will be assigned to the June 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

- (1) To what extent are the provisions of OCGA § 22-1-9 mandatory requirements?
- (2) Did the Court of Appeals err in determining that Petitioner failed to comply with OCGA § 22-1-9 (3)?
- (3) If the provisions of OCGA § 22-1-9 are mandatory and the Court of Appeals correctly determined that Petitioner failed to comply, what is the proper remedy?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
