The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Hines, C. J., Benham and Hunstein, JJ., who dissent. Peterson, J., disqualified.

This case will be assigned to the August 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Whether C/A correctly determined that statement in defendant's brief constituted admission in judicio that trial court should have considered as evidence in weighing the reason for delay under *Barker v. Wingo*, 407 U.S. 514 (1972)?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
