This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Whether in order to be found guilty of criminal trespass under OCGA Section 16-7-21(b) (2), there needs to be proof that the accused entered the premises at issue knowingly and without authority after having received express notice that the entry was forbidden?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
