This case will be assigned to the September 2017 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Is an application for discretionary review required to appeal from an order on a petition for legitimation? See OCGA §§ 5-6-34 (a) (11), 5-6-35 (a) (2). See also *Voyles v. Voyles*, ___ Ga. ___ (___ SE2d ___) (2017 WL 1374760, at *1-3) (Apr. 17, 2017). Compare *Cloud v. Norwood*, 321 Ga. App. 218, 218 (739 SE2d 93) (2013), with *Rodriguez v. Nunez*, 252 Ga. App. 56, 59 (555 SE2d 514) (2001); *In re J.P.*, 267 Ga. 492, 493 & n.2 (480 SE2d 8) (1997); and *Families First v. Gooden*, 211 Ga. App. 272, 274 (439 SE2d 34) (1993).

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
