The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

WARD ANTHONY BROCKMAN v. ERIC SELLERS, WARDEN

From the Superior Court of Butts County.

Before this Court is an application for interlocutory appeal filed by Ward Anthony Brockman to contest a discovery-related order entered in his state habeas proceeding on July 26, 2017. Upon consideration of Brockman's application for interlocutory appeal, the Warden's response, and Brockman's reply, the Court grants the application. Brockman's notice of appeal must be filed in the trial court within ten days of the date shown above. As soon as the record is received from the trial court, and the case is docketed in this Court, the Court intends to remand the case for further in camera review (as requested by the Warden in his response), without prejudice to the claims of error that Brockman asserts in his application. To expedite the preparation of the record and avoid unnecessary delay, Brockman may wish to limit his designation of the record to be transmitted to this Court to the notice of appeal and the order(s) from which the appeal is taken.
