Atlanta February 1, 2018

The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

It is hereby ordered that the Rules of the Supreme Court of Georgia be amended by revising Rule 4 (Requirements for Attorneys Practicing Before the Supreme Court) to add subsection (k) establishing a time period before an attorney who was employed by or a Justice of the Court may enter appearances in cases before the Court.

The amendment shall take effect on February 1, 2018.

I. GENERAL

...
Rule 4. REQUIREMENTS FOR ATTORNEYS PRACTICING BEFORE THE SUPREME COURT.

...
k. Appearances by Former Attorneys or Justices of the Court. An attorney who was an employee of this Court or a former Justice of this Court may not enter an appearance in any case during the six months after his or her service at the Court or in any case that was pending before the Court during his or her service.

All the Justices concur, except Benham and Hunstein, JJ., who dissent.
