The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Melton, P.J., Boggs, Peterson, and Grant, JJ., who dissent.

This case will be assigned to the September 2018 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Is the negligent failure of a municipality to clear vegetation that is adjacent to an intersection of public roads and that blocks the sight of motorists entering the intersection an omission for which municipal immunity is waived by OCGA § 36-33-1 (b)?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
