The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. Hines, C.J., Melton, P. J., Benham, Hunstein, Nahmias, Blackwell, Boggs, and Peterson, JJ., concur.

This case will be assigned to the December 2018 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

- 1) Did the Court of Appeals err in affirming the trial court's ruling admitting evidence of the ALS stipulation at Adams' criminal trial?
- 2) Did the Court of Appeals err in determining that Adams procedurally waived his enumeration of error concerning OCGA § 24-4-403?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
