This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Does the Court of Appeals's approach to deciding whether a prior out-of-state or federal conviction was for a crime that would be a felony if committed within Georgia under OCGA Section 17-10-7 (a) and (c) violate the Sixth Amendment?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
