The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Benham and Hunstein, JJ., who dissent. Bethel, J., disqualified.

This case will be assigned to the February 2019 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

In this case governed by the new Evidence Code, did the Court of Appeals err in holding that the evidence presented at trial was legally sufficient to prove that McKie was a convicted felon?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
