DEKALB COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT et al. v. ELAINE ANN GOLD et al.

Court of Appeals Case No. A18A0526

The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Bethel and Ellington, JJ., who are disqualified.

This case will be assigned to the May 2019 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

(1) What is the proper test for determining whether a statute or ordinance establishing a retirement plan becomes a part of a government employee's contract of employment such that later changes may violate the Impairment Clause of the Georgia Constitution? See Ga. Const. of 1983, Art. I, Sec. I, Para. X.

(2) Did the Court of Appeals apply that test?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
