The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF FAMILY
AND CHILDREN SERVICES v. CLIFTON LEONARD.

Upon consideration of the application for discretionary appeal and the Respondent's response, the application is hereby granted. Applicant must file its notice of appeal in the trial court within ten days of the date shown above. OCGA § 5-6-35 (g). As soon as the record is received from the trial court and the case is docketed in this Court, the Court intends to vacate the superior court's judgment and remand the case to the superior court with direction to conduct the proper due process analysis and make findings as needed, as suggested by both Applicant and Respondent. To expedite the preparation of the record and avoid unnecessary delay, Applicant may wish to limit its designation of the record to be transmitted to this Court to the notice of appeal and the order from which the appeal is taken.
