All the Justices concur, except Blackwell and Peterson, JJ., who dissent.

This case will be assigned to the June 2020 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Was the employer in this case entitled to summary judgment on claims of negligent entrustment, hiring, training, and supervision, because it admitted the applicability of respondeat superior and the plaintiff did not seek punitive damages? See OCGA § 51-12-33.


