The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case.

*Melton, C. J., Nahmias, P. J., and Boggs, Warren, Bethel, and Ellington, JJ., concur. Blackwell and Peterson, JJ., dissent.*

This case will be assigned to the June 2020 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

(1) Whether appellee's lien violated the statutory lien requirements by including an amount for lost profits. See OCGA § 44-14-361 (c); *Stock Bldg. Supply v. Platte River Ins. Co.*, 336 Ga. App. 113, 118-119 (2016).

(2) If so, whether the Court of Appeals erred in vacating the trial court's judgment and directing it to amend appellee's lien.

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
