This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals properly determine that because the measure of damages available in a wrongful death action under the Law of Torts Act of Belize is different from the measure of damages under Georgia wrongful death law, Georgia law applies to this tort case?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
