Did the Court of Appeals err in its determination that the trial court's order on Jefferson's motion for new trial, which granted Jefferson's motion with regard to two counts of armed robbery due to insufficiency of the evidence but denied Jefferson's motion as to all remaining counts, was not a final judgment that could be immediately appealed under OCGA § 5-6-34 (a) (1)?


